## **EFESME** Activities

To open dialogue with other European organisations from the lift or related sectors, in drafting shared political and technical positions for submission to European Institutions as a "sole voice" of the lift sector. To encourage the active participation of SMEs in the decision making processes, whether at national, European, international, technical (standardisation) or political level.

To develop functional actions in support of the establishment of National SME Associations, where they are still not-existent, in order to provide the necessary assistance to successfully cope with EU methodology and structure.

To set up an information exchange framework encouraging a permanent dialogue among its members.

To promote the collaboration and cooperation with other European actors, and to create networks to support SMEs.

#### 06

To work with European institutions to promote SMEs friendly legislation and decision making. To define common initiatives between member organisations in order to promote national debates on European issues.
